## NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Act 62 of the Public Acts of 1956, State of Michigan, the Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages was adopted by reference by the Village Council of Edwardsburg, Cass County, of Michigan on the FIFTH day of MAY, 1969.

The purpose of such Code is to regulate the operation of vehicles, to provide for the regulation and use of streets, highways and alleys and other public and semi-public places within the Village of Edwardsburg and to provide penalties for the violation of said Code.

Adoption of this Ordinance, No. 100, shall supersede any previous ordinance regulating or ordaining any such act as covered in this Ordinance.
