

ORDINANCE NO. 118

(Being an Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Ch.5,
"Relative To Animals Running At Large")

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDAINS:

Section 1.

That Section 1 of Ordinance Ch.5, is hereby repealed.

Section 4.

It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to have, collect, keep or herd any sheep, goats, hogs, pigs, or meat animal within the limits of the Village of Edwardsburg; PROVIDED HOWEVER, it shall be lawful to stable horses within the Village of Edwardsburg, if stabled in a proper barn not closer than ten (10) rods of any dwelling house within said Village; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the stable or barn wherein said horses are kept and the surroundings shall be fenced and shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, so as not to create thereby a nuisance to the public, any person, or sanitary and water conditions on said property.

Section 5.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions in Section 4 above, upon conviction for each and every offense, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

ORDINANCE NO. 118

(Being an Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Ch.5,
"Relative To Animals Running At Large").

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDAINS:

Section 1.

That Section 1 of Ordinance Ch.5, is hereby repealed.

Section 4.

It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to have, collect, keep or herd any sheep, goats, hogs, pigs, or meat animal within the limits of the Village of Edwardsburg; PROVIDED HOWEVER, it shall be lawful to stable horses within the Village of Edwardsburg, if stabled in a proper barn not closer than ten (10) rods of any dwelling house within said Village; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the stable or barn wherein said horses are kept and the surroundings shall be fenced and shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, so as not to create thereby a nuisance to the public, any person, or sanitary and water conditions on said property.

Section 5.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions in Section 4 above, upon conviction for each and every offense, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

ORDINANCE NO. 118, CONTINUED

Section 6.

The Village Council hereby declares that the provisions of this Ordinance are enacted for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Edwardsburg, and that the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby given immediate effect.
