

VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG

ORDINANCE NO. 118

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Edwardsburg, Cass County under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

The Village of Edwardsburg Ordains:

Sec. 1. Agency Designated. Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Electrical Code, in accordance with Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Electrical Official of the Village of Edwardsburg is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Edwardsburg under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Village of Edwardsburg hereby assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the Village corporate limits.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.
