

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A UNIFORM SYSTEM OF NUMBERING FOR ORDINANCES AND TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE RETENTION OF ORDINANCES.

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDINANCES:

SECTION 1. Commencing with Ordinance, all Ordinances now or hereafter enacted by the Village Council of the Village of Edwardsburg shall employ a numbering system which is sequentially numbered during the calendar year of their issuance E. G. Ordinance No. 1993-1; 1993-2; 1994-1; 1994-2, etc. Each Ordinance shall be assigned a number immediately upon enactment, and the text thereof shall be so inscribed with said Number by the Clerk.

SECTION 2. The Clerk shall obtain one or more Notebooks capable of maintaining the original Ordinances, and all Ordinances of the Village of Edwardsburg, heretofore, or hereafter, adopted shall be kept therein. Each Notebook shall have a durable cover, and shall be inscribed with the following legend on the front outside cover:

"The Record of Ordinances
of the
Village of Edwardsburg"

SECTION 3. As required by the Laws of the State of Michigan, each Ordinance when adopted, shall be signed by the President and Clerk of the Village, published in a Newspaper generally circulated in the Village not later than 15 days following its enactment by the Council, and, thereafter, have a Certificate of Publication signed by the Clerk in the substantially the same form as appears at the foot of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The Clerk shall obtain from the Published of the Newspaper which publishes each Ordinance an Affidavit of Publication which has attached thereto the actual published text of the Ordinance, and which is in a form which is identical to that utilized to show proof of publication in Court of Record of the State of Michigan. Said affidavit and copy of the published Ordinance shall be retained by the Clerk in the Record of Ordinances immediately behind the original Ordinance signed by the Clerk.

SECTION 5. The Clerk shall allow the Record of Ordinances to be open to inspection by the Public, and shall make copies of any Ordinance requested by any member of the Public at the same charge as would be set for a demand under the Michigan Freedom of Information Act. The Clerk shall not permit the Record of Ordinances, or any document therein, to be removed from the Village Hall unless commanded to do so by a valid Subpoena or other Order of Court.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated a sum of money sufficient to purchase the Notebooks herein required, and a Seal for the Village if the Clerk and President of the Village determine that the present Seal ought to be replaced.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the first publication of the Ordinance, pursuant to provisions of MCL 66.4.
