

ORDINANCE "F"

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUNISHMENT OF UNLICENSED DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, except those expressly exempted under the provisions of Section 302, Chapter 3, Act 300, of 1949 Michigan, as Amended (M.S.A. 9. 2002), to drive any motor vehicle upon any public street, alley-way, park, or frozen lake within the Village of Edwardsburg, unless such person, upon application, has been licensed as an operator or chauffeur by the Michigan Department of State, under the provisions of Chapter 3, of Act 300, of 1949 Michigan.

Section 2. Every person convicted of violating Section 1 of this Ordinance, shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, or by fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment, together with the costs of prosecution.
