

ORDINANCE "G"

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE RECKLESS DRIVING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG.

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle upon any street, alley-way, public park, frozen public lake, stream or pond, within the Village of Edwardsburg, carelessly and heedlessly, in willful or wanton disregard of the safety of others, or without due caution or circumspection, and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. Every person convicted of reckless driving under Section 1 of this Ordinance, shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not less than five (5) days, nor more than ninety (90) days, or by fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment and the costs of prosecution.
