

ORDINANCE "B"

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE BURNING OF TRASH AND DEBRIS IN THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS THEREIN.

THE VILLAGE OF EDWARDSBURG ORDAINS:

Section 1. The following words, when used herein, shall be deemed to have the meanings given below:

Trash: Worthless or useless matter, rubbish, debris, garbage; any material discarded or abandoned, having substance or body.

Combustible Material: Any inflammable substance.

Incinerator: Any container adequate to control fire or heat generated by burning combustible material.

Person: Any human being, adult or juvenile, a corporation or other legal entity.

Section 2. This Ordinance is adopted in the interest of public safety, convenience and welfare.

Section 3. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of time not to exceed ninety (90) days, costs of prosecution, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 4. No person shall burn, or cause to be burned within the Village of Edwardsburg, any trash or combustible material, as heretofore defined, between the hours of nine (9:00) O'clock P.M. and seven (7:00) O'clock A.M. except for the purpose of providing heat for domestic, commercial or industrial use.

Section 5. No person shall burn, or cause to be burned within the Village of Edwardsburg, any trash or combustible material, as heretofore defined, between the hours of seven (7:00) O'clock A.M. and nine (9:00) O'clock P.M., except for the purpose of providing heat for domestic, commercial or industrial use, unless said trash or combustible material shall be contained in a proper incinerator with said fire under the immediate control of a responsible person; providing however, that it shall be lawful to burn leaves, weeds and dead grasses between the aforesaid times other than in an incinerator if said fire is under the direct and immediate control of a responsible person.
